Report on Career Planning and Development 21st April 2023

Department of Political Science of S.N.D.T. College of Arts and S.C. B. College of Commerce and Science For Women, Churchgate organised the programme on 'Career Planning and Development for Political Science Students' on 21st April 2023 at 2.00 pm to 3.00 pm in the class room 108. Objective of this programme is to make students aware about career opportunities in field of NGOs and Law.

Mr. Eknath Pawar (Programme Coordinator, Praja Foundation) interacted with the students and explained career opportunities in governance field, policy process. He gave examples of Praja interns and their contribution in urban governance with reference to budget, solid waste management in Mumbai Region. He discussed about several positions in NGOs like RTI activist, Personal Assistant to political representative, policy advisor, programme coordinator, data analysis, and field survey investigator. At this time certificates of Prajatantra festival held by Praja organisations were distributed to Ms. Khushaboo Sasmal (SYBA), Ms Rajsheena Saxsena (SYBA) and Ms. Poonam Prajapati (TYBA).

Adv. Glen Aloysius C. (Criminal Defence Attorney at Magistrate, Sessions and High Court) discussed about career opportunities in law field. He explained entrance, best law institutes and courses in India. Mr. Glen discussed the opportunities in law field like litigation lawyer, judicial services, and judicial clerkship. Social activists, public prosecutor, lawyer in PSUs Banks, academics in law, legal journalism arbitration and mediation and legal advisor. He mentioned about Judge Advocate General in the Indian Army posts as well. It is short term service and one can apply it till 27 years. Both the sessions were enjoyed by students and questions were asked. Anmol Jadhav, Aditi Nate and Niyati Wadkar faculty of departments coordinated the event.
